Background and Analysis:

The Irwindale Community Foundation Car Show Ad-Hoc Committee has recently been informed that the Park @ Live Oak is no longer able to host the planned Car Show at its site. As a result, a special meeting has been called for the Board to discuss and consider the following options:

1. Alternative Sites: The Ad-Hoc Committee is actively working on finding another site within the City to host this event. More details will be provided at the meeting.
2. Alternative Event: The Ad-Hoc Committee has discussed having a "Taste of" event in lieu of the Car Show. As of now, this idea has been discussed and the Ad-Hoc Committee is awaiting alternative site information prior to determining if an alternative event should be considered by the Board.
3. Date of Event: As of now, the event is scheduled for September 27th. Given the current

circumstances, the Ad-Hoc is discussing a possible date change. However, this will be determined once the details regarding the site and type of event are determined.
