The Irwindale Community Foundation may direct staff to investigate and/or schedule certain matters for consideration at a future Board meeting.

SPONTANEOUS COMMUNICATIONS

This is the time set aside for members of the audience to speak on items not on this agenda. State law prohibits any Board discussion or action on such communications unless 1) the Board by majority vote finds that a catastrophe or emergency exists; or 2) the Board by at least four votes finds that the matter (and need for action thereon) arose within the last five days. Since the Council cannot (except as stated) participate it is requested that all such communications be made in writing so as to be included on the next agenda for full discussion and action.

Any public member addressing the Board shall limit comments to three (3) minutes regarding the subject under discussion. If a member of the public wishes to donate their time to another speaker, both persons must be physically present and in attendance of the meeting. In no event shall any donations of time exceed six minutes of total speaking time per person on any one item. The Presiding Officer may, in his or her discretion, extend the 3-minute time limitation for the particular subject under discussion for all speakers. In no event shall the total amount of speaking time exceed 6 minutes per person for the subject under discussion. Organized group of persons wishing to address the Board on the same subject matter, should select a spokesperson to represent the group, so as to avoid unnecessary repetition. The Board may regulate a speaker who is speaking too long, being unduly repetitious, or extending discussion of irrelevancies.
